EXHIBIT CONTEST RULES:

1. Application Deadline
 - A. An application must be filed with the Exhibit Chairperson by certified mail, return receipt requested, postmarked no later than September 4, 2016.
 - B. All application must include a copy of your current MSRT membership card.

2. Eligibility
 - A. Professional competition: Only professional technologists who are in good standing with the MSRT at the time of application shall be considered eligible.
 - B. Student competition: Only student technologists who are members in good standing with the MSRT on or before July 1 of the current year shall be considered eligible.
 - C. Group entries: Each entrant must meet eligibility requirements and must submit a separate, completed application form.

3. Subject Matter
 - A. Exhibits should be pertinent to diagnostic and therapeutic technology and other subspecialties involving imaging modalities.

4. Exhibits
 - A. Exhibits may not be commercially executed. All work must be original.
 - B. Exhibitors must provide their own viewboxes or other illumination devices.
 - C. Exhibits must be completely set up by 5:00 PM, September 30th, and removed by 1pm, October 2nd, 2016.
 - D. Neither this committee nor the conference committee will be responsible for the exhibit material left after the appointed removal time.
 - E. Each exhibit will be provided with a table, approximately two feet by four feet in size.
 - F. Exhibits shall bear no identifications as to exhibitor identification, hospital or office.

5. Judging

Exhibits will be judged according to the following scale:

A.	Originality of thought of subject matter	0-30 points
B.	Educational or technical value	0-40 points
C.	General interest and practical value to a large number of technologists	0-10 points
D.	Technical quality (including descriptive material, photographs, graphs, charts, radiographs, etc)	0-10 points
E.	Preparation and presentation (composition, arrangement and neatness, etc.)	0-10 points
F.	Three judges will be appointed by the President of the MSRT and shall be answerable only to the President.	
G.	The decision of the judges will be final.
